This monster of a wine, leads with black cassis, dark plum, blackberry, crushed rock, cigar box, and violet aromas. The wine itself is stuffed with concentrated dark fruits, cassis liqueur, toasted vanilla bean, and mineral elements, with an exotic floral hint that lingers on the palate. This is a compelling and powerful wine, the essence of Klipsun Old Vine Cabernet. It will be fun to follow it for two decades or more.

Rich, fullbodied, concentrated and layered, it's a beautiful wine that's going to benefit from short term cellaring and keep for two decades.
