

2018 CABERNET SAUVIGNON WALLA WALLA VALLEY

Jeb Dunnuck | Another one of the top wines in the vintage is the 2018 Cabernet Sauvignon Walla Walla Valley, which is all Cabernet sourced from the Seven Hills and Pepper Bridge Vineyard. It spent 21 months in 60% new French oak. Gorgeous tobacco, bouquet garni, lavender, and a hint of menthol emerge from the glass, and it has loads and red and black fruits, full-bodied richness, ripe, polished tannins, and a great finish. It's as seamless as they come yet will still benefit from 4-5 years of bottle age and should have 30 years of longevity.
