Tasted out of barrel, the 2014 Walla Walla Valley Cabernet Sauvignon sports an inky, opaque color to go with classic Walla Walla notes of smoked duck, currants, licorice and chocolate. Rich, concentrated, yet still fresh and lively, with present tannin and a great finish, it should be reasonably approachable on release yet cruise for 15-20 years in the cellar.

A joint venture between football stars Damon Huard and Dan Marino, these terrific Cabernets are made by Chris Peterson at his Avennia winery. The change in 2014 was the decision to focus on appellation specific wines, and they've moved from a single Cabernet Sauvignon to three different cuvees: one from Walla Walla, one from Red Mountain and one from Horse Heaven Hills.

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
