Complex and deep aromas of black currant, blackberry, blueberry, crushed violets, freshly ground Ethiopian coffee, mocha, and damp earth notes. This wine features a palate-coating texture, dense with blackberry, blueberry, cassis, dark chocolate, and liquid minerals. Rich and approachable, yet fierce in structure, the ultimate “iron fist in a velvet glove.” Long, full opulent finish. Great power and poise. Give it 2-3 years in the cellar, and drink it over the next twenty years, at least.
